FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 23

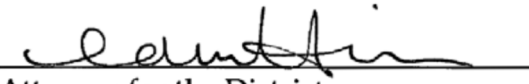
The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 23 will hold a regular meeting on **Thursday, December 18, 2025, at 5:30 p.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, Phoenix Tower, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2400, Angelina Room, Houston, Texas*, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the items listed below:

1. Public comments (maximum 3 minutes per person).**
2. **CONSENT AGENDA:** The following items are considered routine by the Board and will be enacted by one motion. No separate discussion will occur on these items unless a Board member so requests, in which event the item will be removed and placed on the Non-Consent Agenda.
 - a. Approve minutes.
 - b. Tax assessment and collection matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
 - c. Operation of District facilities, including billings, repairs and maintenance, customer correspondence, message language on bills, and delinquent back charges.
 - d. Garbage and recycling matters.
 - e. Phase II Small MS4 General Permit and Storm Water Management Plan, including status of compliance, necessary training and public comment.
3. **NON-CONSENT AGENDA**
 - a. Items removed from the Consent Agenda.
 - b. Garbage and recycling matters, including annual Consumer Price Index adjustment.
 - c. Authorize auditor to conduct audit for fiscal year end December 31, 2025.
 - d. Review Sales Tax Audit Report.
 - e. Authorize renewal of District's insurance policies.
 - f. Update on EVO Report and 10-year budget forecast, consider entering into new contract with Municipal Information Systems, and take appropriate action.
 - g. Parks and recreational facilities matters, including:
 - i. update on pending repairs and authorize additional repairs and improvements as appropriate;
 - ii. design of park facilities, plan approval, advertisement for bids, contract award, and pay estimates for park construction projects, including:
 - aa. 10-acre park tract;
 - iii. update on Master Park and Trail Plan; and
 - iv. Texas Parks and Wildlife Recreational Grant.

- h. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including:
 - i. payment of the bills and review of investments;
 - ii. adopt District and regional facilities budgets for fiscal year end December 31, 2026; and
 - iii. Travel Reimbursement Guidelines and Director Expenses for the Association of Water Board Directors winter conference.
- i. Engineer's report, including:
 - i. authorize design of facilities, approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for projects in the District, including:
 - aa. Teal Run Estates Drainage Channel Rehabilitation; and
 - bb. Water Supply Plant No. 1 Automatic Transfer Switch and Generator replacement;
 - ii. review bids and award contracts for projects in the District;
 - iii. approve pay estimates, change orders and final acceptance as appropriate, including:
 - aa. wastewater treatment plant improvements; and
 - bb. waterline and sanitary sewer extensions along South Post Oak Boulevard;
 - iv. proposal for rerating the wastewater treatment plant;
 - v. Capital Improvement Plan;
 - vi. South Post Oak Boulevard extension, including sidewalks and CenterPoint easement agreement;
 - vii. Lake Olympia Parkway;
 - viii. Chimney Rock Road;
 - ix. Westenfeldt Road;
 - x. West Sycamore Road;
 - xi. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment requests, including conveyance of various tracts to the District;
 - xii. expansion of the regional water system;
 - xiii. Fort Bend County drainage matters; and
 - xiv. development in the District.
- j. Update on District annexation matters and take appropriate action, including:
 - i. approve annexation letter agreement;
 - ii. authorize execution of Developer Financing Agreement; and
 - iii. take other appropriate action.
- k. Update on Temporary Out-of-District Service Agreement with Fort Bend County for the Boys & Girls Club tract and take appropriate action.
- l. Approve Risk and Resilience Assessment and filing of certification of same with the Environmental Protection Agency.

- m. Additional operating matters, including hearing on the termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers, authorize termination of service, and process uncollectible accounts as applicable.
- n. Amend Rate Order.
- o. Update on wastewater treatment plant oxidation ditch repair insurance reimbursement.
- p. District security matters.
- q. Administrative manager/building matters.
- r. District website and communication matters, including approve related proposals and correspondence.
- s. District amenities operation and maintenance matters, including:
 - i. discuss operation and maintenance matters for the tennis courts, take appropriate action, and consider terminating Donation Agreement Regarding Recreational Facilities Maintenance between the District, Winfield Lakes Homeowners Association, and Winfield Lakes Community Association.
- t. Update on District condemnation action and take appropriate action.
- u. Historical bond and tax report to Comptroller.
- v. Review and update Eminent Domain Report to the Texas Comptroller.
- w. Reports from Directors and District consultants on District operations.
- 4. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, to conduct a private consultation with attorney to discuss pending or contemplated litigation, or a settlement offer.
- 5. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding pending or contemplated litigation, or a settlement offer.

** A statement of no more than 3 minutes may be made of items of general relevance or related to items listed on the posted meeting agenda. There will be no yielding of time to another person. State law prohibits the Board from commenting on any statement or engagement in dialogue without an appropriate agenda item being posted in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act. Comments should be directed to the entire Board, not individual members. Engaging in verbal attacks or comments intended to insult, abuse, malign, or slander any individual shall be cause for termination of time privileges.
